NMU pilot course offered by Jacobs University Bremen in March 2010

“Northern Maritime University” (NMU) project, a collaboration network of universities from different European countries with expertise in maritime transport, is currently developing multidisciplinary qualifications that are focused to meet the needs of maritime industries today and in the future. Different pilot courses targeting different target groups of students and stakeholders are running simultaneously during this Spring semester at each partner university.

The **Workgroup Maritime Logistics** of Jacobs University Bremen has been developed an e-learning module-element called “**Ship Knowledge**” in **e-learning module**. The e-learning course will run for 5 weeks start from 8th March 2010. NMU Stakeholders and students from NMU partner universities are invited to participate in this course.

Short Course Description:

Ship knowledge module introduces different types of ships, which are used widely nowadays. It describes the ships various characteristics and respective types of cargoes and their applications. Some 3-dimensional views of ships are provided, therefore learners can visualise or indicate each part, space, the size of compartment compared to the whole ship.

Learning Objectives:

- To provide basic knowledge of different kind of ships as well as related terms used in the shipping industry
- To understand the key important aspects of the ship as the basics to support managerial decision during ship operation and for further advanced maritime studies
